What if I think that I want to become Catholic?

We believe that God extends his personal call to individuals to learn more about whom God is and what he has done for all of us, He extends his loving invitation to recognize our sinfulness and our need to receive God's reconciling love offered through his life, death and resurrection. Jesus calls us to become members of his body which is the Church. The fullness of Jesus' plan for humanity can be found in the Catholic Church. If you want to become Catholic or simply want to explore the Catholic faith, you will participate in a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (often called RCIA or simply Christian initiation.) Adults or children who have reached the age of reason (about 7 years old) will begin to explore and learn about the teachings of Jesus through the Church he founded and continue to lead
