**From the Director . . . Rita Minkley**

**It's Lent . . . Are you ready?**

Spring is in the air. Winter stillness is giving way to a flurry of activity. The clocks are about to move into daylight savings time. I am noticing vibrant green leaves emerging on once barren shrubs and trees. Buds are beginning to thicken. The grass is looking decidedly greener. The weeds are having a great time popping up all over the yard. As we move into spring it is natural to wander the yard looking for the first

green shoots to poke through the soil or the first fat buds on the roses to break open in vivid color. We long for the promised regeneration to begin.

And it is the beginning of Lent. While we wait, we can take advantage of our annual Lenten pilgrimage to slow our pace a bit and assess the integrity of our life in faith. Lent is the journey taken wide-awake into spring and all that season's signs of hope and new life. It is an extended journey remembering the passion and death of Jesus and his time in the tomb. We know the end of the story—his rising to new life. Lent is an opportunity to consider our own journey through life in anticipation of resurrected life in God.

With all these signs of spring peeking out, it is hard to find a quiet place within to reflect on the Lenten season. And yet, we need to cultivate a place of quiet within – a place where all the distractions of the routine

and busy day are set aside so we can ponder the mystery of dying and rising to new life. Lent is the journey that asks us to take the time to be still and ponder how we will generate new life in ourselves and in those we serve. Will our almsgiving be a thoughtful decision to diminish ourselves so another can flourish? Will our time be consumed with self-serving activity or will we fast from self-centeredness and be food for the person hungry to be listened to? Will we ramble in unreflected words of prayer or will we sit in silence before our God who is ever waiting for our attention?

Spend time in quiet. Do not allow this Lent to slip by unnoticed. Cultivate your awareness. Pay attention throughout your Lenten journey. Like the first flowers of spring we finally notice, Easter Alleluias, long awaited, will burst upon us and be glorious.

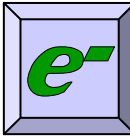

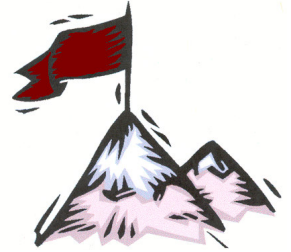
