The Key to Happiness – Early Registration

The phone rings on Thursday afternoon. A Catechetical Center staff member answers it to hear, “Is the Level 2 course starting next Wednesday evening still on? I want to register for it—I only need that one and one other to finish my Level 2 certification.” Alas, the staff member must reply, “No, that course has been canceled due to a lack of registered participants.”

The phone rings on Friday morning. A Catechetical Center staff member answers it to hear, “I need to register for the Level 1 workshop being held at the Pastoral Center tomorrow.” Again, unfortunately, the staff member must reply that the workshop has been canceled due to an insufficient number of registrations. Those who do not call in advance and come as walk-ins find a cancellation notice posted on the door.

The Catechetical Center does not like to cancel scheduled Level 1 workshops or Level 2 courses. It frustrates those who have registered and are looking forward to attending. It frustrates those who need particular workshops or courses to complete their formation process for certification. It frustrates the instructors who have been preparing for these workshops and classes. And it frustrates the Center staff when we cannot follow through with the formation opportunities we want to provide for catechists throughout the archdiocese. However, to hold a workshop or course as scheduled when less than the required number of participants have registered before the registration deadline just is not feasible—for financial, facility management or staffing reasons.

How many of you have ever hosted an event and invited a large group of people, only to have a limited number respond to say they would attend? This is where

things start to get nerve-wracking: how many of those who did not respond will show up?—will there be enough food?—will the facility accommodate the number of people who come?—will there be enough supplies to meet the demand? These are the same issues we face for every workshop and course we schedule. We have deadlines because of the many details that have to be taken care of to prepare for a workshop or course, details that cannot wait until the last minute.

Registration deadlines are:

Level 1 workshops - one week prior to the workshop date.

Level 2 courses - ten days prior to the first class session.

To plan for and provide the best possible formation opportunities both the Catechetical Center staff and our workshop and course instructors need the number of registered participants in advance. So plan ahead and REGISTER EARLY!
