Applying for Certification

*Once all 25 lessons have been completed, the individual must print a copy of the online certificate and submit it, along with the application for certification (available at <https://www.archsa.org/academy/>), to his or her principal, who will send it on behalf of the teacher to the Archdiocese of San Antonio Academy for Lay Ecclesial Ministry. **The individual must assure that the application is complete. An incomplete application will be returned to the individual.***

Expiration and Renewal

- Certification for Teachers who Do Not Teach Religion is good for 4 years only.
- 10 clock hours of continuing education credit are required annually after Certification is achieved.
- Continuing education includes workshops and conferences of a religious nature sponsored by Catholic institutions.
- Must re-apply for Certification after 4 years and provide documentation of hours of continuing education credit during each year.

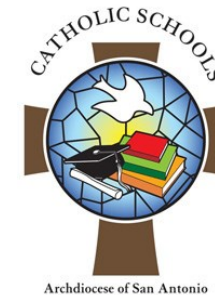

Archdiocesan Certification for Teachers in Catholic Schools Who Do Not Teach Religion is required for all teachers in the Catholic Schools of the Archdiocese of San Antonio from Pre-K to 12th Grade who do not teach religion. It helps to assure that they have a sufficient knowledge of the teachings and practice of the Catholic Church to foster and support the essential faith-based environment of a Catholic School.

Archdiocesan Certification for Teachers in Catholic Schools Who Do Not teach Religion presents the teachings of the Catholic Faith in an interactive format that presents the lesson through videotaped presentations which draw from Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Using a mix of solid content, personal stories, prayer and discussion questions, this course makes it easy to learn and understand the Church's teaching about topics such as the Revelation, Prayer, the Mass and the Sacraments. The course also seeks to answer common questions that Catholics encounter each day.
