Adult Safe Environment Training

As a CYO coach for the Archdiocese of San Antonio, you are required to receive Adult Safe Environment Training. The USCCB mandates that all clergy, staff, candidates for ordination, and volunteers who have contact with children/youth must be trained in abuse prevention. In order to receive your CYO badge, you must complete the training and present your completion certificate to the CYO office. Training can be conducted at a training location or online.

To register:

- Go to archsa.org
- Click on the Child Protection page
- Click on the Safe Environment Training tab
- Click on the Protecting God's Children link
- Create a login and password
- Enter your personal information
- Select your ministry location
- Select any alternate locations
- Select your ministry and identify yourself as a CYO coach
- Click "No" for already attending a Virtus Protecting God's Children
- Select a training date or scroll to the bottom and select the online option
